veggies to your meals



stovetop carrots *a tasty side dish!*

1 pound fresh carrots
1 tablespoon butter
¼ teaspoon salt
¼ teaspoon
black pepper

1. Peel carrots and cut into slices.
2. Place the carrots, ¼ cup water, salt and black pepper in a skillet. Cover and cook over medium heat until carrots are tender, about 4 to 5 minutes.
3. Remove the cover and add the butter. Stir and cook until water is absorbed, about 2 to 3 minutes.



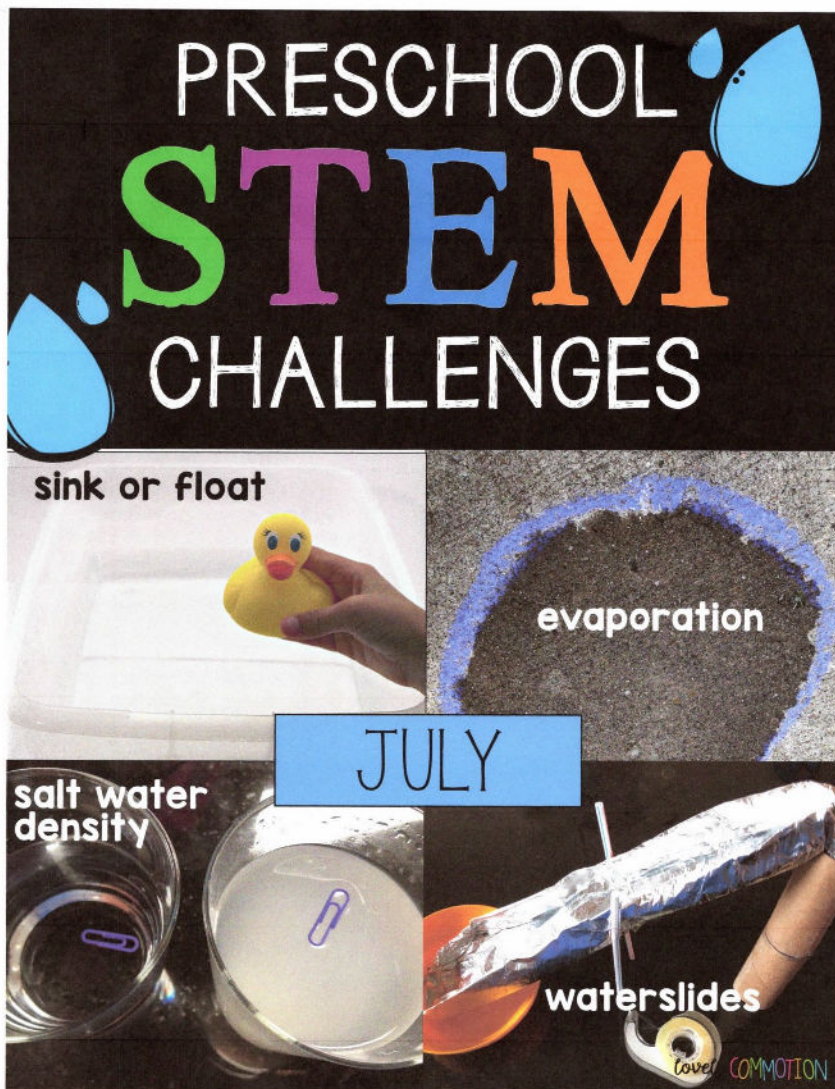
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TEACHER OF THE MONTH

STEM Projects FOR July

Week 1 Have you noticed that when you go swimming some toys sink and some toys float? The children will talk about why some items sink while others float, and then conduct an experiment.

Week 2 Have you been to the ocean? Have you noticed that the water is different than the water that comes out of our sinks? It's Salty! Will the items from last week float instead of sink if the water is salty? The kids will test to find out.

Week 3 Have you ever built something fun and got really excited about your creation? This week the children will be provided with materials and have the challenge to build a waterslide.

Week 4 It sure gets hot in the summer! We seem to drink a lot which is good cause we need water to stay hydrated. Have you ever spilled water while playing outside? Have you noticed that your spill disappears in the sun? What happens to the water?
