WEEK 2

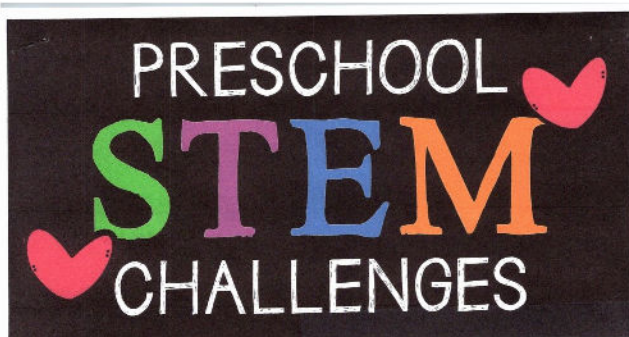
How tall can we make a tower? The children will experiment to see how tall they can get their tower before it falls. They will talk about height and balance.
